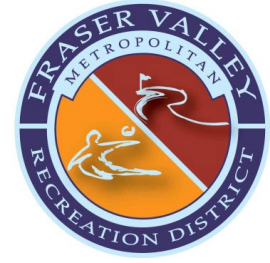

### **REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:**

- Knowledge of food and beverage types, their preparation, ingredients, and presentation.
- Excellent customer service skills to interact effectively with all types and ages of guests.
- Proficient mathematical and computer skills to handle money effectively.
- Ability to multi-task to effectively provide service to a large number of guests at one time.
- Ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing.
- Ability to read and interpret written documents and manuals.
- Ability to establish and maintain an effective working relationship with staff members, patrons, and the general public.
- Ability to work evenings, weekends, and holidays as necessary.

### **EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE:**

- High school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent.
- Prior serving experience preferred.

**Work Environment:** Work is performed in a restaurant, bar, and kitchen environment and may include periods of high activity with noise levels from quiet to loud and exposure to hot and cold temperatures. Employees will be required to read safety data sheets and understand all safety precautions when handling chemicals or hazardous cleaning materials.

**Physical Requirements:** This position requires good vision and hearing. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, kneel, stoop, squat, pull, push, climb, and lift moderate to heavy loads.
